



**“If you were Prime Minister for the day, and could change one thing, what would it be?”**




**Lots of children and young people said:

We want to show people who are in charge of the country what disabled children and young people want to change.


## **The top three changes that disabled children and young people want:**

Hannah, 16




**Lots of young people said:**
